Dear Parent (s)/Guardian(s):

Welcome to Marris Elementary! The 2018-2019 school year will soon be underway, and we are pleased to have you as partners in this educational year. The first day of school for students will be Wednesday, **August 8th**. Regular school hours are 8:10 a.m. – 2:45 p.m. This will be a full day for our students who are in Kindergarten through 5th grades. The price for a student lunch will be \$1.95. Reduced lunch is 40 cents. Student breakfast is \$1.25, reduced breakfast is 30 cents.

This year, all textbook rental fees can be paid online using Skyward Family Access, with no service charges applied for either textbook payments or lunch money paid on account. Textbook rental fees can also be paid in person at the Junior High School Bookstore located at 701 Tile Factory Road. Please enter through the Junior High main entrance, Door #1. Hours for the Bookstore will be:

Thursday, August 2nd 8:00 a.m.-5:00 p.m.
Friday, August 3rd 8:00 a.m.-5:00 p.m.
Saturday, August 4th 8:00 a.m.-1:00 p.m.
Monday, August 6th 8:00 a.m.-5:00 p.m.

Although payment can be made through Skyward Family Access at any time, the last day to pay textbook rental fees at the Bookstore will be Monday, August 6. No payments will be accepted at any school location on Tuesday, August 7 to allow us time to transfer payment records to each individual school. Beginning on Wednesday, August 8, textbook rental fees must be paid at individual school buildings or paid online. Skyward Family Access and the Bookstore allow credit or debit card payments. Cash, checks, or money orders can be accepted at the Bookstore or school buildings. Textbook rental fees for the 2018-2019 school year are:
